DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

Background:

The Division supports the recovery of repair or replacement costs from individuals or groups causing damage to Division property.

Definitions:

Cost:

means direct and indirect costs to repair damage including, but not limited to, labour, material and contract services.

Procedures:

- 1. Where property has been intentionally or negligently damaged or destroyed by a student, the cost of repair or replacement or subsequent cost to the Division caused by a person's action shall be recovered from the student or the parent/guardian.
- 2. The Principal shall inform the parent/guardian, in writing, of the incident that occurred and the claim for recovery that shall be issued when the costs have been determined.
- 3. Extreme incidents of vandalism involving students may be reported to the police.
- 4. Where property has been identified as intentionally or negligently damaged by an individual or group other than a Division student, the pursuit of costs shall be determined by the school or department in conjunction with the Director of Financial Services.
- 5. All damage to property shall be reported to the Principal or Director. The Principal or Director shall advise the appropriate departments as necessary.
- 6. The appropriate department shall provide either the costs of repair or replacement, or an estimate of the cost to repair the damages.
- 7. Unpaid invoices may be turned over to a collection agency at the discretion of the school or department after two reminder notices.
- 8. Funds received shall be forwarded for processing to the school or department incurring the repair costs.
