Dear Ministik School families;

We wish to advise you that earlier today, the Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS) Board of Trustees voted in favour of closing Ministik School as of June 30, 2017. In addition, a second motion was passed to re-designate Ministik School students, including those registered for kindergarten, to Fultonvale Elementary Junior High for the 2017–2018 school year.

EIPS is committed to working closely with you and your children to ensure the transition to the new school is handled smoothly. Much in the way that we transition students and their families as they move from elementary to junior high, EIPS will implement a school transition plan which includes communicating with students and families, school council groups from both Ministik School and Fultonvale Elementary Junior High, school administration and staff. Additionally, we will ensure facility requirements, support services, library resources, staffing and student transportation are dealt with well in advance of the first day of classes on Aug. 30, 2017.
