3. Teacher Assigned Instructional Time

Assigned instructional time for teachers equates to approximately 890 hours per year.

4. Staff Meetings

First staff meeting - September 1
All subsequent staff meetings shall be the 1st instructional Wednesday of the month.

5. Recess or Period Breaks

Elementary Principals are responsible for scheduling two recess breaks.
Schools with alternative recess break schedules should advise Human Resources.
Junior/Senior High Principals are responsible for scheduling period breaks.

6. School Based Professional Learning Days

Schools have two days (Aug 26, Mar 4) for staff to meet and work on items such as:
School Education Plans, sharing best practices, building continuity with programs, assessment, teacher-educational assistant meetings.
