SMOKE, VAPE AND TOBACCO-FREE FACILITIES

Background:

Smoking, vaping and the use of tobacco products in any form by students, employees and other persons are not conducive to the maintenance of a healthy environment. All Division premises and vehicles will be smoke, vape and tobacco-free, and all school-sponsored activities shall be smoke, vape and tobacco-free.

Procedures:

- 1. All Division buildings, vehicles and grounds are designated smoke, vape and tobacco-free.
- 2. The Principal shall ensure all students, staff, parents/guardians, visitors and community user-groups are made aware of the smoke, vape and tobacco-free requirement.
- 3. Smoking, vaping and the use of tobacco products are prohibited at any school-sponsored graduation ceremony or activity.
- 4. Supervisors shall inform their staff members the use of tobacco is prohibited in or on Division-owned property.
- 5. Any student or staff member in violation of these procedures shall be subject to disciplinary action.
- 6. Any student possessing a vape, vape paraphernalia or tobacco product shall have it confiscated for disposal by the school.
- 7. With the prior approval of the Principal or Supervisor, the use of tobacco is permitted as part of religious and ceremonial events.
