






### **Programming**


The regular program is offered at Andrew School. There are no Alternative Programs and System programs.

## **Andrew School Fact Sheet 2022-23**

### Methodology

**Capacity:** The number of students a school facility can accommodate—obtained from the 2021-22 Area Capacity Utilization Report.

**Enrolment:** The number of students attending a school as of Sept. 12, 2022—the number often fluctuates throughout the year.

**Enrolment Breakdown:** The number of students attending a school by grade as of Sept. 30, 2021. When a student attends an alternative program, they are accounted for in the Alternative Program—regardless of the school's attendance boundary.

**Enrolment Trends:** The enrolment trend for the school using historical data and the following projection formulas: Births + Migration + Housing Yield = Population Population X Participation Rate = Enrolment.

**Facility Information:** The school's building information, such as the year it was primarily constructed and the facility's size, measured in square-metres.

**Full-Time Equivalent (FTE):** The number of full-time staff working at a school, certificated and classified staff, as of Sept. 12, 2022—the number often varies throughout the year.

**Population Density in Attendance Area:** The number of children living within the school attendance area—obtained using the current federal census, municipal census provincial birth registries, Canada Revenue Agency and student enrolment information.

**Utilization Rate:** A measure used to determine the relative occupancy level for a school—obtained from the 2021-22 Area Capacity Utilization Report.

### **Terminology**

**Infrastructure Maintenance and Renewal (IMR):** The annual funding provided to a school jurisdiction to cover expenses related to:

- replacing building and site components that have failed and pose health-and-safety problems for students and staff;
- extending the useful life of school facilities and sites; and
- maintaining the quality of the school environment.

**Alternative Programs:** As per Alberta Education's definition, alternative programs emphasize a particular language, culture, religion, subject matter, or use a particular teaching philosophy—different from special education programs.

**System Programs:** Alberta Education's Standards for Special Education describes special education as the education of students with mild, moderate or severe disabilities and those gifted and talented.
