French Immersion

This program is offered at select Elk Island Public Schools from Kindergarten to Grade 12.

Instruction is based on Alberta Education Programs of Study and designed for children whose first language is *not* French.

Typically, students begin French immersion in Kindergarten or Grade 1.

- > Students are immersed in "French only" from K-2.
- Students start formal English instruction in Gr. 3.





Enriched Learning Environment

French is the language of instruction for a significant part of the school day creating an environment for students to become fluent in the language. Just as they would in the English program, French Immersion students receive a high-level education with innovative technologies and learning methodologies. The program also includes field trips, guest speakers and cultural events.

A Foundation for Success

- ► French Immersion creates a foundation for students to achieve success now and in the future providing opportunities for exchanges and travel, scholarships and bursaries, and earning an International Language Proficiency Certification.
- ► Fluency in French may increase career options, especially in tourism, diplomatic service, politics, teaching, research, marketing and civil service. In fact, almost half of jobs in the Federal Government of Canada require applicants to be bilingual in Canada's two official languages, according to a 2017 report by the Clerk of the Privy Council.



Why consider the EIPS French Immersion program?

Students who continue in French Immersion to graduation will see the biggest rewards and open up post-secondary opportunities.

Learning a new language makes it easier for students to learn additional languages.

Having a second language builds confidence in students and enhances creativity, critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

French is one of Canada's two official languages and is spoken by 220 million people around the world.

Common Questions

What if I don't speak French?


Parents of French Immersion students are not expected to know how to speak French.

Will my child's English skills suffer?

Research has shown that a second language can significantly strengthen first language skills.

- ➤ How do I know my child is keeping up?
- How do I help my child when I don't speak the language?
- My child has a learning disability, would this program suit him?
- > Is the curriculum any different?

Note: Be prepared for children to learn at a different rate than their English program counter parts.

School Life

French Immersion Certificate Criteria

Elk Island will award a French Immersion Certificate to students who:

- Complete at least two courses in French (one of which must be FLA) at the 30-level
- ➤ At least 30 total credits in French Immersion (six courses) over the three years in high school.

*Courses offered at the high school level depend on that year's interest and student body. Over the past few years, Biologie 30 and Chimie 30 have been offered in alternating years.



- ➤ Once in French Language Arts 30, students will have the opportunity to write the DELF exam at the B2 level.
- ▶ What is the DELF exam?
 - ➤ Le Diplome d'etudes de langue française (DELF) is an international diploma officially awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify the French language skills of candidates from outside France.
- ► The certification is good for life!
- ▶ At this level, the student has a degree of fluency and spontaneity in interactions and can correct their own mistakes.



Why students may take the DELF...

- ➤ To be assessed with the same international language standards as candidates in 173 countries
- ➤ To continue studies at a French university
- ➤ To complement language education with a universally recognized diploma


- ► The variety of course we offer in French French Language Arts, Biology, Chemistry, Social Studies, Math at all levels as well as Science 10
