## **Function and Purpose of Position**

Under the supervision of the structural foreman the painter is responsible for the daily execution of duties as assigned by organizing, scheduling, carrying out and monitoring the completion of the work in his/her area of responsibility. The painter is responsible for all aspects of the painter trade.

Carry out all routine in-house maintenance, preventative maintenance programs, emergency, minor maintenance and special projects as assigned by the structural foreman.

Perform all aspects of the painter trade in accordance with standard trade practices, standards and building codes; organize the selection, drawing and delivery of materials and special equipment to the work site; prioritize, coordinate and schedule assigned work with building occupants and other trades and/or contractors for optimum efficiency and minimum disruption in the schools.

Activity C: \_\_10\_%

Prepare and/or complete administrative documentation associated with timekeeping, work order system, and material and special equipment requests. Catalogue paint colors used by Facility Services and Contractors.

Activity D: \_\_<u>10</u>\_\_%

Work with other Facility Services personnel, specialized trades and contractors in the design of specialized maintenance work and projects.

Activity E: \_\_<u>5</u>\_%

Carry out assigned inspections and investigate problems, provide solutions, prepare reports, sketches, and detailed estimates; during normal daily routine identify problems and report them to the appropriate foreman.

  - iv) Must possess a valid Alberta's Drivers Licence and meet requirements of the Elk Island public Schools Vehicle and Equipment Operating Manual.

- Ability to operate specialized equipment such as fork lift, spray paint equipment and man lift.
