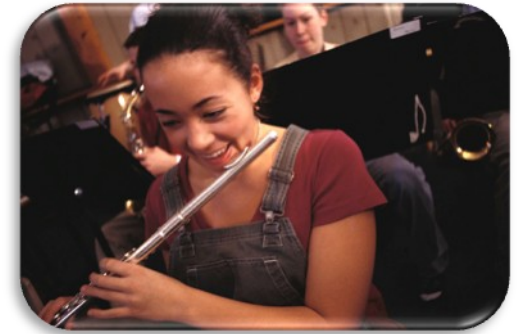
DARE Program
